When should I arrive?

Village Cinema Coburg Drive-In opens at 8pm each evening. We advise arriving by 8.45pm so you can easily park your car. Each film begins at 9.15pm

Can I watch the film without a car?

No, unfortunately due to the current COVID restrictions, you will need a car.

How do I listen to the sound?

When you arrive, set your radio frequency to 95.9FM, the channel used for films playing on Screen 3. This information will also be available at the screening.

I don't have a radio in my car, how can I listen to the film?

Village Cinema Coburg Drive-In can loan you a radio free of charge. Please go to the box office before the film begins. They will require your driver's license which will be returned to you after the film ends.

Can we sit outside of the car or on the roof?

No, due to the Covid 19 restrictions, you should only leave the car to use the Facilities or pick up the food from the Diner. You can also order food through the Diner's app and it can be brought to you.

What happens if it rains?

We are still able to screen films if there is rain.

What if I get a flat battery?

Village Cinema Coburg Drive-In will be able jump start your car for you. If this is needed please go to the box office. If you are concerned during the screening you may wish to turn on your car engine for a few minutes during the film. Please be mindful of revving and the use of headlights.

I have a low clearance vehicle, am I able to reserve a spot at the front?

Unfortunately no, there are no reserved car spots. People with low clearance vehicles are encouraged to arrive promptly to find suitable parking. Likewise, people with high clearance and larger vehicles are encouraged to park in the back rows.

How long can I stay after the film?

There are other films screening after the CaSFFA 2020 sessions so please vacate promptly.

How do I purchase food from the Village Cinema Coburg Drive-In Diner?

The Diner has an app that allows you to order food which will then be brought to your car. Download the 'Coburg Drive-In Diner' app from the Apple App Store or Google Play store. Once you make your food selection, please state the closest pole number near your car and food will be delivered to you. There are some vegan, gluten free, and halal options. Please check the website for more details.

Are there bins for rubbish?

Yes, please dispose of rubbish in the bins provided before you leave or take it with you. Do not litter from your car.

Are there toilet facilities?

Yes. The toilets are in the same building as the Diner.

Etiquette

As per Village Cinema Coburg Drive-In code of conduct, anyone acting in an excessively noisy, rowdy, or abusive way will be escorted off the premises by Village Cinema staff.

Am I allowed to use my headlights?

Please be mindful of using headlights and back lights, particularly once the film has started.

Can I reserve a parking spot for a friend's car?

No, you are not allowed to reserve parking spots.

Am I allowed to smoke?

We ask that you do not smoke in public areas.

Am I allowed to record the film?

As with any cinema attendance, any illegal recording (of images and/or sound) is forbidden under copyright law. People doing this will have their devices wiped and be asked to leave. If you would like to take pictures of your experience at Village Cinema Coburg Drive-In for non-commercial use you are welcome to.

Is my dog allowed to attend?

Yes, you are allowed to bring pets though please be mindful of disruptions particularly when the films are screening.
